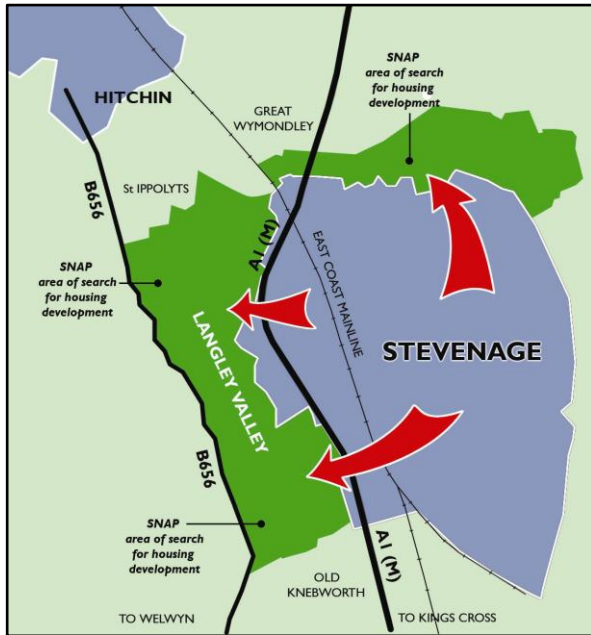


UTTER MADNESS!

SNAP Consultation

These are my answers to some of the SNAP questions:

- Question 1.** No, the boundary of SNAP is not appropriate. The Langley Valley should be excluded from the search area.
- Question 2.** No, the Visions and Objectives are not right. They cannot be effectively applied to development in a rural area like the Langley Valley.
- Question 3.** The features that need to be retained are, importantly, the countryside, flora and fauna of the Langley Valley.
- Question 4.** New housing should be located elsewhere than the Western sector of SNAP map 2.
- Question 10.** There should be no new road links between development West of Stevenage and the B656 Hitchin to Welwyn road.
